* We accept payments by mail, and we
take the postmark on the envelope if on
or before the due date. *(Please be patient,
mail takes time to process as we have a lot of walk
in customers.)*

* You can pay with a credit card on the
website listed below as well
as in person. *(We can no longer take
payments over the phone due to high
volume.)*

*(You will need to create an account to view
your property information and make a
payment. They charge a 3% fee to process the
payment).*

* Partial payments are accepted. Please call
the office for more information.

* Our office has a locked drop box that you
can put payments into. A receipt will be
mailed **if requested**. The drop box is located
near the front entry of the building.

* **Please call our office for a correct payoff
amount if your payment is mailed in after the
due date.** We do not send refund checks, so
sending the correct amount helps your
payment get processed faster. *(We cannot
hold funds to apply to a future tax bill).*

* **Summer Tax and Winter Tax
payments MUST
be on separate checks.**

Garbage Pickup Reminders:

The Waste Management drivers start pickup
at 6:00am on Monday morning.
*(If Monday is a national holiday, trash will be
picked up on Tuesday instead).*

* Please make sure your trash is out to the road
no later than 6:00am on Monday.

* Each week, you are allowed to put out one large
item *(weather permitting).*

* Garbage bags should weigh no more
than fifty pounds. **GARBAGE MUST BE BAGGED.**

* Waste Management will not pick up any
building materials. You must take those items to a
dump or arrange for a dumpster.

* All Businesses within the township must make
their own trash pickup arrangements. The
Township contract is for Residential homes only
(vacant parcels are not included in this contract).

Assessor's Office

* **The Assessor's office would like to remind any
Business taxpayers with personal property under
\$180,000 true cash value who have not filed form
5076- Small Business Property Tax Exemption
Claim to do so. FILING THIS FORM CAN SAVE TAX
DOLLARS. The form must be filed no later than
Feb. 20, 2024.**

Assessment notices will be mailed
out mid-February.

* **NOTE:** The deadline is now June 1st for filing a
new PRE Exemption as the school operating
millage is now collected on the summer tax bill.
