Attention Compost Site Users: *A permit is required to use the compost site. A free site permit is available to Denton residents & property owners. Also, a non-resident permit, is available at a cost of \$25.00 annually and a commercial permit at a cost of \$150.00 annually. These may be picked up at the township office during regular office hours: 8am to 4pm, Monday thru Friday.*

Note: *Non-resident and commercial permits are for compost use only.*

Newspaper- Bundle in paper bag or tie with string or twine. No coupon pages or envelopes. No staples.

High Grade Paper- Computer paper or office paper. Bundle in paper bag or tie with string or twine.

Magazines- Glossy paper magazines & catalogs with glossy paper (JC Penney, Sears, etc.). Non-glossy magazines, such as phone books, please bundle separately.

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes- No cereal boxes, beer cases, wax coated boxes, cellophane wrappers or liners. Flatten and bundle so they can be easily handled.

Plastics #1 and #2- Milk, cider and laundry jugs. No oil, dry gas or anti-freeze jugs. Please clean and remove caps.

Tin Cans- No paint or aerosol cans. Please clean and remove paper labels, remove both ends and flatten.

Aluminum- Foil, pie and T.V. dinner plates. Please clean and flatten when possible.

Yard Waste & Rocks- Leaves, grass clippings, brush, rocks (that can be carried) and Christmas trees. No logs over 6" diameter, building materials or broken furniture. Paper yard waste bags must be biodegradable. *No plastic or garbage bags with leaves. Leaves and grass must be dumped out of the bags unless the bags are biodegradable.*

E-Waste- **No longer accepted** (*may also be taken semi-annually to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection or put out with your weekly trash as your "one large item"*)
