

**Public Hearing &
Special Board Meeting
Denton Township Board
November 13, 2017**

Meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m.

Board Members Present: Spaulding, Asher, Seaford, Fuller and Pedersen.

Also Present: Nine (9) members of the public and the Houghton Lake Resorter Reporter Cheryl Holladay.

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear public comments on the Michigan Medical Marihuana Act (MMMA).

Supervisor Spaulding opened the meeting by giving a brief synopsis of what has transpired from the State of Michigan and some of the issues that have been arising over the last 8 years. He explained that PA 281 of 2016 authorizes Townships to approve five (5) types of facilities which are: grow facilities, processor, transporters, provisioning centers (dispensary) and safety testing facility. The Township has three options which need to be decided on by the Board. The options are adopt an ordinance allowing any of the facilities listed above, adopt an ordinance stating that there can be no facilities allowed in the Township or do nothing at this time.

Clerk Asher stated that several telephone calls were received that were against any facilities in the Township and Mr. Jack Brown of Old Trail Drive came to the office on Monday, November 13, 2017 to go on record saying he was against any facilities in the Township.

Several comments were heard and some questions answered.

No action taken by the Township Board.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
