

**Special Board Meeting
Denton Township Board
December 10 2018**

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Board Members Present: Spaulding, Asher, Seaford, Fuller and Pedersen.

The purpose of the meeting was to have the first budget workshop.

At the start of the meeting, Maintenance Foreman, Jim Hoover stopped in at 9:05 a.m. to let the Board know that the overhead garage door at the compost site needs to be replaced.

Motion by Fuller supported by Pedersen to have Hoover get a new overhead garage door installed for the compost site building at a cost not to exceed \$2,500.00.

To begin the budget prep several items were discussed for the 2019-2020 budget as follows: possible purchase of the old Surplus store on M-55 and M-18, wages for several employees and elected officials, repairs and upkeep for the Township Building and the Stone Hall. A new General ledger account will be opened for Dangerous Building expense. Fees in different departments were reviewed such as zoning permits, stone hall rental, mobile home annual rent and garage sale permit fee.

Also discussed was how best to handle the Blight and Tall Grass and Weed Ordinance complaints.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:25 p.m.
