

**Special Board Meeting
& Public Hearing
Denton Township Board
January 9, 2019**

Meeting called to order at 6:00 p.m.

Board Members Present: Spaulding, Asher, Seaford, Fuller and Pedersen.

Also Present: April Hehir from ATC Group Services, Julie Lowe, Brownfield Coordinator for the DEQ and Christian Bon, Geologist with the DEQ. Also, approximately 54 concerned citizens were present.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the concept of the Township purchasing the old Surplus store and other buildings and garage located at the corner of M-55 and M-18.

April Hehir gave a short presentation with a time-line of events that have transpired since March of 2018. A Phase I and a Phase II assessment have been completed. A Baseline Environmental Assessment would need to be completed by whomever purchases the buildings. The representatives from the DEQ explained two of the grants that may be available to help with the project and possible demo of said buildings.

There were many questions answered. By a show of hands it is the people's opinion that the buildings are an eyesore and should be removed.
